Candidates with a 4-year Bachelor's degree with research (without Master's) must have at least 75% marks or an equivalent grade. Foreign degrees equivalent to Master's or M.Phil. will be considered if certified by an appropriate accreditation authority. Candidates who have qualified NET / JRF / INSPIRE are exempted from PET and may directly attend the in - person interview
