The session also emphasized the need for a multidisciplinary approach involving law enforcement, legal aid providers, counselors, and educators to address the issue effectively.</p> |

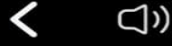

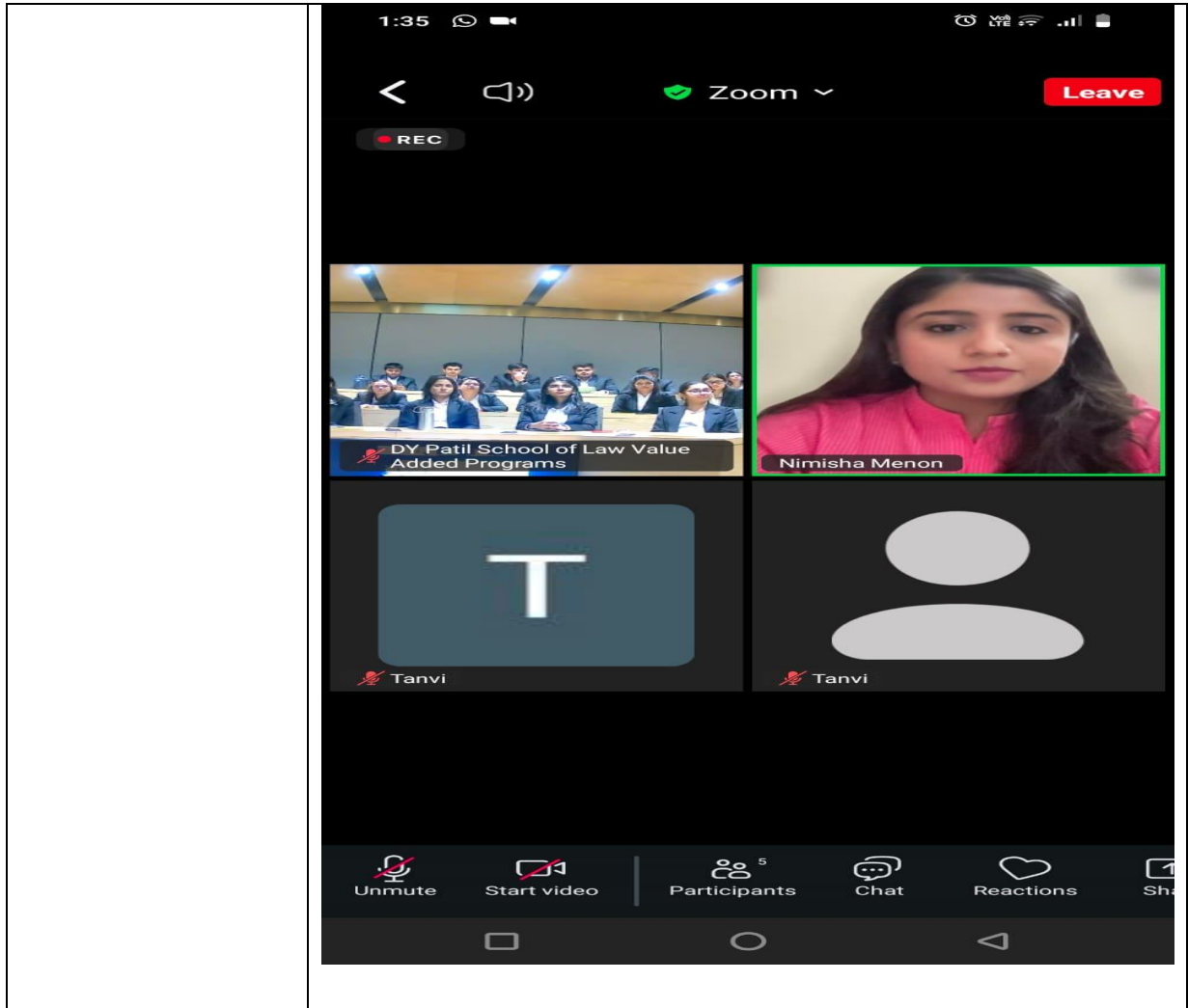
