### **4. Participation from Vijay Patil School of Management**

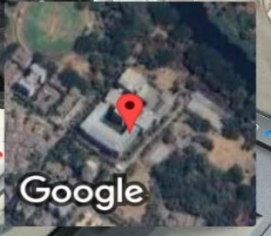
